## Activity Ideas

### Before your online workshop

Before you take part in Remembrance online, you may want to prepare your pupils by using some of these activity/discussion ideas:

- How do we remember people from the past and things that happened with physical things? Think of as many ideas as you can (hints - statues and sculptures, murals, memorial plaques, street signs, etc..)
- What did you eat for dinner yesterday; one week ago; two weeks ago? Is it easy or difficult to remember these sorts of things? If you went on holiday last year, is where you went and what you did there easier to remember? Discuss with your class why it might be easier to remember some types of things and harder to remember others

**After your online workshop**

- Finish making your poppy by adding drawings of people and things you can remember
- Perhaps you can make some blue pop-up cornflowers for your school display – these are the flowers of remembrance used in France and they make an attractive contrast to the poppy
- Visit a war memorial near to where you live, or to your school – see if it tells you why its there and look at the list of people it is there to remember
- Draw your local war memorial – perhaps take a photo of it to help you?
