Each site has a 4D Theatre and a Simulator as well as Virtual Reality headsets – these fun activities can transport you into a realistic virtual world as you soar through the skies in an aircraft! The RAF Museum at London has a fantastic RAF-themed outdoor play area, whilst RAF Museum Cosford has the Fun 'n' Flight Interactive Gallery!

Both sites also have shops where you can buy a whole range of exciting goodies, including aircraft models, stationery and other RAF-themed treats. Don't forget about the cafés too – who doesn't love to eat some delicious treats?

If you have access to a printer, ask for an adult's permission and print some photographs of your favourite exhibitions. If not, you could draw them. Take a look at our example poster templates, or why not create your own design?
