13.02.43	<p><b>Aircraft:</b> Supermarine Spitfire MK1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Single seat [redacted]</li> <li>• [redacted] 7.7mm machine guns, [redacted] in each wing</li> <li>• Top speed: [redacted] mph</li> </ul> <p><b>Observations:</b> What an exciting day! I flew from RAF Cosford to RAF Boscombe Down to deliver a Spitfire to No. [redacted] Squadron for Pilot James [redacted]. Rumour has it he is going to be awarded the [redacted] Cross.</p>
15.02.43	<p><b>Aircraft:</b> [redacted] Defiant MK1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• [redacted] seat fighter</li> <li>• All armament located in a [redacted] turret behind the cockpit</li> <li>• Manufactured in [redacted]</li> </ul> <p><b>Observations:</b> Today I delivered the Defiant to the No. [redacted] Polish Squadron - what brave chaps they are! Combating the Luftwaffe in the [redacted] of Britain. The aircraft will mainly be flown at night.</p>

Its nickname comes from the Popeye cartoons, how funny! The Wellington is being used less and less these days. This one will eventually head to North [redacted] as a [redacted] aircraft.</p>
21.02.43	<p><b>Aircraft:</b> Junkers [redacted]</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This aircraft is a [redacted] all-rounder</li> <li>• The engines were made by [redacted]</li> <li>• [redacted] for FUG 212 Lichtenstein C-1 [redacted]</li> </ul> <p><b>Observations:</b> Jolly exciting night at RAF [redacted]. A [redacted] Junker was flown over the North Sea and landed here! It was flown by a Luftwaffe (German) crew, who were unhappy with the Nazi regime.
