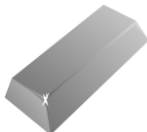
These planes are called flying boats and have been made to travel in the air and to land on the sea.

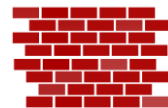

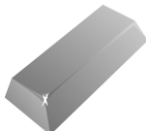

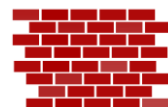
